Roulette

Roulette is one of the older, classic casino games and is very easy to play. The dealer spins a numbered wheel and a ball in opposite directions. The object of the game is to predict where the ball will come to rest and place a wager on the corresponding numbered compartment (0, 00, 1 - 36). All wagers corresponding to the winning number are paid according to the following paytable.

One number – straight-up	35:1
Two numbers - split	17:1
Three numbers – street	11:1
Four numbers – corner	8:1
Five numbers – top line	6:1
Six numbers – line	5:1
12-number sections	2:1
12-number columns	2:1
1-18 and 19-36	1:1
Red and black	1:1
Odd and even	1:1

Wagers may be placed in each round of play up to the time the dealer announces, "no more bets". When the ball comes to rest, the dealer will place a marker on the winning number on the layout and pay all winning wagers.

Roulette uses special non-value chips, which you assign the value of when you buy them. To avoid confusion, each player receives a different color chip and each chip may be played only on the table at which it was issued and only by one player at a time. Before leaving the roulette table, all non-value chips must be exchanged for cash chips.
