



On April 5, 2022, the Maryland Racing Commission approved a request from the Cloverleaf Standardbred Owners Association to implement the following policy effective immediately when a trainer has a medication violation:

1. All licenses held by the trainer are suspended during the suspension period.
2. While under suspension, the trainer shall be denied access to all areas under the jurisdiction of the MRC, including the grandstand and clubhouse.
3. The horse found in violation shall be suspended from racing during the time of the trainer's suspension
4. Any horse owned or partially owned by the suspended trainer shall not be transferred to another trainer for racing purposes
5. Any suspension issued shall be served during a live race meet in Maryland.
